Tulp Festival takes you through Amsterdam



Tulp Festival brightens up Amsterdam's streets throughout April and sends you on a journey of discovery along dozens of locations with hundreds of thousands of tulips. From North to Southeast and from East to New-West, tulips in bloom mark through routes and enliven shopping streets and centres, squares and bridges in all parts of the city. The colorful spring flower blooms in the course of April aldso in the full ground in parks and gardens of museums and hotels. Tulp Festival gives color to residential areas and the photogenic tulip is a lovely inspiration for the most beautiful pictures. Tulip routes

Admire tulips on the route from Damrak via Dam, Rokin and Vijzelstraat to the Weteringcircuit; on Koningsplein and Leidseplein. Take a tulip tour on the Museumplein and in the streets of the surrounding Museum Quarter. In West you can take a tulip walk from Mercatorplein along Kwakersplein, Bellamyplein, Witte de Withplein, Van Limburg Stirumplein and Frederik Hendrikplantsoen. The squares invite you to sit down and have a chat. If you go north, tulips will accompany you when getting of the ferry on IJpromenade and Buiksloterweg. Going east from Central Station, you will pass tulips on De Ruyterkade, Veemkade and Brazilplein. In Southeast, the tulips meander from Anton de Komplein through the Amsterdamse Poort. At other shopping centres, such as Osdorpplein and Gelderlandplein, colorful tulips in large tubs welcome the visitor.

Exhibition 100 tulip varieties

Take a look at the free exhibition of 100 tulip varieties in the public garden of the Hermitage Museum at Amstel 51. At this historic Amsterdam site 5,000 special tulips are displayed. Admire the striking colors and shapes and explore the range of worldwide popular varieties to exclusive, new tulips that recently came onto the market. (Garden is open during museum hours.)



Find the New Santa

Last Autumn, 250 Amsterdam citizens planted the red and white fringed New Santa in their facade garden. The tulip beds can be seen in residential areas throughout the city. Residents who managed to obtain the free tulip bulbs – a gift from the Amsterdam Tulip Museum and the Tulip Festival - are thus making a colorful contribution to the motto 'A tulip for every citizen of Amsterdam'.

Tulips in the full ground

This beautiful Spring probably let us enjoy an early start of blooming tulips in the full ground. You may spot them in several places. While walking in Amsterdamse Bos, Vondelpark or Erasmuspark you will come across dozens of varieties of tulips. A 'secret' spot is the Botanical Garden Zuidas with beautiful tulips. Exuberant tulip presentations can also be admired in the gardens of the Rijksmuseum, the Willet-Holthuysen museum, the Hilton Hotel on the Apollolaan, Hotel Pulitzer on the Prinsengracht and the Waldorf Astoria on the Herengracht. Other special locations are quays, for example the Bilderdijkkade, Leliegracht and Herengracht and in North the Tuttifrutti garden in Tuindorp Oostzaan, for which the Tulip Festival donated the bulbs.
