The 12th edition of Tulp Festival will bring colour to Amsterdam in April 2026



The 12th edition of the annual Amsterdam Tulp Festival will bring colour to the capital in April 2026. Dozens of locations across the city's districts and neighbourhoods will be filled with masses of tulips in public spaces. Tulips in tubs and platters will enliven streets and squares, bridges and gardens, under the motto “a Tulip for every Amsterdammer”. The Nieuw West district will be the first to feature organic tulips at various locations near shopping centres and in residential neighbourhoods. Organically grown tulips will also float on rafts in the pond in Vondelpark. Throughout April, the Amsterdam Tulp Festival will take you on a journey of discovery to dozens of locations with hundreds of thousands of tulips. The Tulp Festival brightens up shopping areas and residential neighbourhoods, and the photogenic tulip can be beautifully immortalised everywhere. Sustainable and organically grown tulips

Tulp Festival Amsterdam supports the aim to use organic tulip bulbs. In the coming years, the proportion of organic tulips will continue to increase. At present, there are simply not enough available for the whole city. Tulp Festival Amsterdam works with a supplier from North Holland, who in turn purchases the tulip bulbs from certified bulb growers in the region with certificates such as GLOBAL.GAP and MPS-A; a number of them are affiliated with NLG Holland (Natural Living and Growth Holland).
